

II. TOOL LIST

- \checkmark 2 people required
- ✓ Basic tool set
- ✓ Blue masking tape
- ✓ 19mm socket
- ✓ 1 1/8 " socket
- ✓ 1 1/8" wrench
- ✓ Ratchet extension

III. VEHICLE PREPARATION

- 1. Park vehicle on level surface.
- 2. Engage parking brake, chalk tires, and disconnect battery.
- 3. Using blue masking tape, mask along the profile of your truck above the bumper. This will help protect your truck from any accidental scratches.



IV. REMOVAL OF OE BUMPER

1. Using a 1 1/8" socket and a 1 1/8" wrench, remove 4 bolts attaching OE tow point to frame. Remove and set aside.



2. Using a 19mm socket or wrench, remove six bolts attaching OE bumper to frame of truck. Using a crane or hoist, hold weight of bumper while removing bolts. Remove bumper and set aside.








INSTALLATION OF HAMMERHEAD BUMPER

1. Using a 19mm socket and hardware from hardware kit #221, attach frame sub weldment (*ITEM 3*) to frame of truck as shown below. Do not fully tighten.




2. Slide weldnut tab into back of frame. Using a 1 1/8" wrench or socket and hardware from hardware kit #42, secure frame sub weldment to frame of truck as shown below. Adjust frame sub weldment to be centered on truck and fully tighten all hardware.





3. Using a hoist or a few friends, attach bumper to frame subweldment using hardware kit #124 as shown below. Start all bolts before aligning bumper. Align bumper a minimum of 3/8" below fascia. When truck flexes off-road, this distance allows your bumper and body to have clearance. Fully tighten bolts with 1 1/8" socket and wrench. Extra hardware is included in hardware kit #42 to install tow hook to frame sub weldment.
